PREPARATION FOR RECYCLING

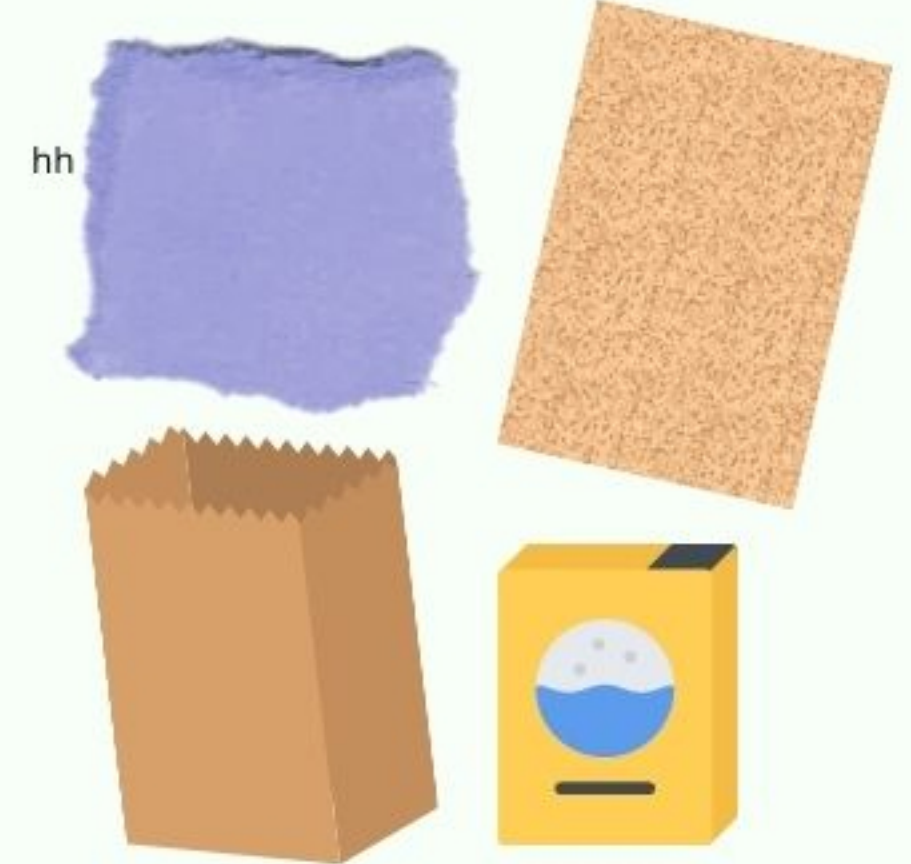
- 1 Separate white papers and colored papers. Make sure papers are not laminated
- 2 Remove papers with food and drink residues since those cannot be recycled
- 3 Clean the papers by removing tapes, staple wires, stickers, plastics and any solid residues
- 4 Dry the papers before stacking
- 5 Flatten the papers to save space

RECYCLING GUIDE FOR CARTONS



PREPARATION FOR RECYCLING

- 1 Empty the cartons of their contents, ensuring that they are completely free of liquids or food remnants.
- 2 Dry the cartons before stacking
- 3 Remove any non-paper components from the cartons, such as plastic spouts or caps.
- 4 Flatten the cartons and stack neatly to save space during storage and transportation.
